

Topic: Gaining New Grounds

Text: Joshua 13:1

"Now Joshua was old and stricken in years; and the Lord said unto him, Thou art old and stricken in years, and there remaineth yet very much land to be possessed".

Gaining New grounds is to make progress, to experience advancement in life. From the Scriptures we see God begin to speak to Joshua at the twilight of His life, indicating that there are new lands to be possessed, We can be rest on our laurels, there still more of God to discover.

Acts 6: 7

- We must Engage in Prayer to New Ground- Every New Ground demands a warfare

- Continually examine yourself- Re evaluate things consistently
- Your Passion for more of God should be consistent, When Passion to seek God dies , growth and new experience are inhibited. For every Christian, Spiritual Hunger is key to seeking daily for God.
