 ${ }^{13}$ So he called ten of his servants, and gave them ten minas [one apiece, each equal to about a hundred days' wages] and said to them, 'Do business [with this] until I return.'
## Luke 19:13 King James Version

${ }^{15}$ When he returned, after receiving the kingdom, he ordered that these servants, to whom he had given the money, be called to him, that he might find out what business they had done.

## Luke 19:16 King James Version

${ }^{16}$ The first one came before him and said, 'Lord, your mina has made ten more minas.'
${ }^{17}$ And he said to him, 'Well done, good servant! Because you proved yourself faithful and trustworthy in a very little thing, you shall [now] have authority over ten cities [in my kingdom].'

## Luke 19:18 King James Version

${ }^{18}$ The second one came and said,' 'Lord, your mina has made five minas.'
${ }^{19}$ And he said to him also, 'And you shall take charge over five cities.' ${ }^{20}$ Then another came and said,' 'Lord, here is your mina, which I have kept laid up in a handkerchief [for safekeeping].
